Rules

1. All competition items will be accepted from 8.00am on Sunday 30th August. No exhibits will be accepted after 10.00am.
2. Dog Show entries taken from 12.00noon only.
3. Make sure that you retain your entry form for the purpose of reclaiming your items at the appointed time.
4. **Items exhibited cannot or will not be released until the prize giving. All exhibits must be collected before 6pm.**
5. Any exhibitor who wish to sell their produce may do so.
6. No Hawkers allowed. All animals entered at persons own risk.
7. The Committee is not responsible for loss or damage to exhibits.
8. All exhibitors pay. All helpers must pay to re-enter exhibition after the judging.
9. Judging is anonymous all exhibitors will be allocated a unique number, which will be displayed on all exhibits by one exhibitor.
10. All entry forms must be received no later than 21/08/09 to Úna Bhán Tourism, Grounds of King House, Boyle. Late entries will not be accepted.
11. Min of 5 entries per category to select 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prize
12. Min of 3 entries per category to select 1st place only

Safety Conditions

1. All dogs must be on leash. All other pets must be in cages or baskets.
2. Animals, other than guide dogs are not permitted inside the exhibition area.
3. Any person in charge of an animal who in the opinion of the judges, committee member, or safety officer is causing a disturbance or is a danger to the public in any way will be asked to remove the animal from the grounds. The decision of the safety officer will be final.
4. All vehicles are parked at the owners risk
5. Parents please note All children must be accompanied by an adult while on community grounds and show fields.
6. Children must be constantly supervised and kept safe distance from all animals, vehicles and machinery.
7. Use of amenities at own risk.
8. Your co-operation with the Show Committee will ensure an enjoyable and trouble free day for all.

Where an entry contains more than 1 item, (such as 3 carrots) then all should be as even as possible.
Vegetables are not judged solely on size. Points awarded on uniformity of size, quality, freshness & artistic appearance of exhibit.
Produce not included on category list, will be deemed for artistic presentation only.

Carrots & Parsnips

Leave a little of the leaf stalks on.

Leave as much of the main root on as is possible.

Remove fine side roots if present.

In carrots do not select roots with green at top of the root.

If prepared the previous evening then wrap in wet newspaper to maintain freshness.

Cabbage

Round heads look best. Remove some of the big outer leaves, not all.

Onions

If possible harvest 3 weeks previously & dry. Select only ones with thin necks. Do not peel. Tie necks neatly with elastic or thread.

Turnips and Swedes

Select smallest roots with smooth skin

Broccoli

Select heads that are green - no sign of flowers opening. Handle very carefully. Leave as long as possible but cut fresh when exhibiting.

Selection of 5 vegetables.

Potatoes or parsley do *not* count

Flowers

In wet weather previous to show day it is advised to protect blooms. Always leave some foliage on.
