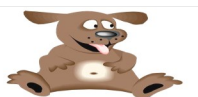

## **BOYLE SHOW DANCE**

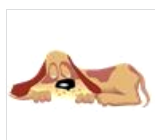

## ARROWROCK HOSTEL

Situated on the Sligo / Roscommon border Arrowrock Hostel stands on the shores of Lough Arrow, an area of conversation and great natural beauty, rich in archaeological remains (Lough is Gaelic for Lake). Arrowrock Hostel is a former hotel offering great rooms, cosy common areas, beautiful dining room overlooking the lake, large self catering kitchen, BBQ area, garden and there own lake shore pier. Why not visit them and experience the history, archaeology, the myths and legends and the spectacular scenery in this region.

Take in The Labby Driving & Walking Tour, a circuit of the lake and it's surroundings, from Carrowkeel Megalithic Site (over 5,000 yrs old) to the plains of The Battle of Moytura, other well known sites on the tour include Heapstown Cairn, Labby Rock, Ballindoon Abbey, Lough Key and the Curlews Mountains and much more, sections of the Arigna Miner's Way and Historical Trail (a 143 km marked national walking route) are included in this tour.
